

WISE ROAD TO CLOSE JULY 7, BOGIE LAKE ROAD TO CARROLL LAKE ROAD FOR CULVERT REPLACEMENT

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Commerce Township, will replace the 81-year-old Wise Road culvert over the Huron River between Bogie Lake Road/Commerce Road and Carroll Lake Road.

ROAD IMPROVEMENTS


- Replacement of the current twin corrugated metal culverts with a 26.5-foot precast concrete culvert and head and wing walls.
- Construction of an eight-foot-wide sidewalk along the north side of the culvert to connect to a pathway in the future.
- Reconstruction of the roadway in the vicinity of the culvert.

ROAD CLOSURES & SCHEDULES

- Wise Road will be closed to through traffic between Bogie Lake and Carroll Lake roads during the project.
- Access to homes and subdivision streets within the closed section will be allowed on either side of the culvert.
- The project is expected to start, and the road close, on July 7.
- Work is expected to be completed in early October.

DETOUR ROUTE

During the closure, the detour route for through traffic will be Commerce Road to East Commerce Road to Carroll Lake Road and back to Wise Road and vice versa.



PROJECT COST & CONTRACTOR

The project will cost \$1.9 million and is being paid for with federal road funding and contributions from the Road Commission.

The contractor for the project is Z Contractors Inc. of Shelby Township.
