ITEM 1: PUBLIC COMMENTS

ITEM 5: LYSTEK BOND AUTHORIZATION

Supervisor Gray moved ITEM 5: LYSTEK BOND AUTHORIZATION to follow ITEM 1: PUBLIC COMMENTS on the agenda.

Treasurer Phillips laid out the tight timeline to apply for the SRF loan and asked the Board of Trustees to approve the Resolution authorizing the notice of publication of the Township's intent to issue bonds as collateral for the SRF loan. The Board of Trustees discussed the merits of all 3 proposals. During the discussion the Board of Trustees learned that Commerce Equestrian Management, LLC submitted inaccurate information in their proposal.

ITEM 3: SELECTION OF CONCESSIONAIRE (continue)

MOTION by Weber, supported Berkheiser, to disqualify Commerce Equestrian Management, LLC from consideration due to the submission of inaccurate information.

MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

The Board of Trustees agreed to perform due diligence on LP Equine Unlimited through the Horse Farm Sub-Committee. The Horse Farm Sub-Committee will investigate the true capabilities of LP Equine Unlimited, conduct additional interviews, review financial statements, and begin preliminary contract discussions. The Board of Trustees will submit additional questions to LP Equine Unlimited through the Horse Farm Sub-Committee.

MOTION by Sovel, supported by Berkheiser, to enter into discussions with LP Equine Unlimited through the Horse Farm Sub-Committee with the Horse Farm Sub-Committee reporting back to the full Board of Trustees with its recommendation. **MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY**
